Citrus Heights Water District (CHWD) is offering a rebate up to \$75 for the purchase and installation of a qualifying High-Efficiency Clothes Washer (HECW).

IMPORTANT: PLEASE READ ALL PROGRAM RULES AND REBATE REQUIREMENTS BEFORE SUBMITTING YOUR APPLICATION.

Please read the Rebate Program Requirements on the backside of this Application. Qualifying HECWs must be labeled “ENERGY STAR Most Efficient” to obtain the maximum rebate or “Energy Star Certified” to obtain the standard rebate as per the current Qualifying Product List (<https://www.energystar.gov/productfinder/product/certified-clothes-washers/results>).

All rebate applications require the signature of the property owner (if different than the applicant). Indicate the manufacturer name and model of the HECW and the purchase price (excluding sales tax and labor). Complete the Account & Applicant Information below.

High-Efficiency Clothes Washer Rebate Application: Rules & Requirements

1. Rebate application must be submitted within 90 days of purchase. An original, dated sales receipt must have itemized cost, form of payment and name of vendor. If you need the original receipt(s) returned, please enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope with your rebate application. For online purchases, a print out of the final invoice and an original packing or delivery slip is required.
2. All rebate applications must be signed by the legal property owner.
3. Qualifying HECWs must be labeled "ENERGY STAR Most Efficient" or "Energy Star Certified" as per the current Qualifying Product List.
4. There is a limit of one HECW rebate per service connection.
5. No rebate will exceed the purchase price of the item. Sales tax and labor are not rebated.
6. The rebated equipment must be installed at an existing Citrus Heights Water District (CHWD) service address prior to rebate request. New development is not eligible for rebates.
7. Rebates will be issued in the form of a check. The account must be in good standing to receive a rebate. Upon closing an account, any rebate credit balance will be mailed to the account holder. Allow four weeks from the date of the rebate approval for check processing.
8. Installation of any rebated device, appliance or fixture is the sole responsibility of the applicant, as is determination of the adequacy and compatibility of the existing plumbing system.
9. The applicant is solely responsible for the proper disposal of all materials associated with the installation of rebated fixtures and equipment and CHWD assumes no responsibility or liability. Please recycle materials.
10. CHWD does not guarantee materials or workmanship; acceptance of such is customer's responsibility.
11. CHWD assumes no responsibility or liability for any damage that may occur to an applicant's property as a result of participation in this program. Due to circumstances beyond its control, CHWD cannot guarantee that installation of rebated fixtures or measures will result in lower utility costs.
12. The IRS requires all rebate program participants receiving \$600 or more per calendar year in rebates to be issued an IRS Form 1099 unless exemptions apply. If you have received rebates from CHWD totaling \$600 or more in the current calendar year, you must submit a completed IRS W-9 form (see our website for a copy of this form) with your rebate application to receive a rebate.
13. CHWD may at any time, modify, suspend, or terminate this program without prior written notice.
14. A CHWD representative must be permitted to inspect the property to verify installation.
15. Incomplete or illegible applications will be denied.
